5. BYU students who have chosen to complete the paper version of the course are advised to make copies of all assignments before submitting them. BYU will not give credit for papers lost in the mail.
6. External Credit Recovery Options may be used only to make up credit for a course that a student has previously failed.
7. South Suburban College may require a placement test. Remedial level courses, course numbers below 100, are not accepted for high school credit with the exception of some math courses.
