- Residency – must be a resident of south suburban Cook County.
- Youth between the ages of 16 and 21 years old
- Low Income (Food Stamp Recipient, TANF or SSI Recipient, or Proof of Family Income)

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION:

- Proof of citizenship (Authorization to work in the United States/Date of Birth)
- Compliance with Selective Service (Male born on or after 01/01/1960)
- Proof of Residency of Suburban Cook County (South Suburban Cook County)
- Social Security Card
- Low Income Verification
