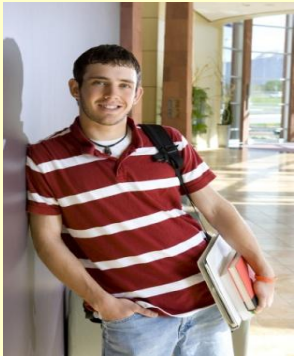


A Must See Event!
