**Summer School Student Information and Agreement**

**Attendance Information:**

1. There is a maximum of **TWO (2) ABSENCES** (excused or unexcused), per half credit courses and **FOUR (4) ABSENCES** (excused or unexcused), for full credit courses.
2. Students are dropped from summer school on the **third** absence (for half credit courses), or on the **fifth** absence (for full credit courses).
3. The attendance policy begins on the first day of summer school.
4. State law determines the attendance policy; therefore, no alterations are allowed.

**Tardy Information:**

1. **THREE (3) TARDIES** to class equal **ONE (1) ABSENCE** (this includes breaks).
2. Student is **dropped** from school on the **fourth** tardy for a half credit course.
3. There is a limit of **six** tardies (excused or unexcused) for a full credit course. Students are dropped from summer school on the **seventh** tardy.
4. Tardies include being tardy to school, as well as being tardy to class when returning from break.

**Discipline Information:**

Students must follow the District 205 discipline policy at all times. This policy is detailed in the student handbook provided to all students during the regular school year. Please see an administrator if you need information on the discipline policy.

**Things to Know:**

1. Disruptive behavior is not permissible. Students, who display behavior problems in school, on the bus, or on school grounds will be dropped from summer school. Students dropped from summer school because of behavior will not receive a refund or a passing grade.
2. Current I.D. cards must be displayed properly with name, picture, and number facing forward. I.D. cards must be worn at all times during the school day. I.D. cards may be worn that display a student's home school. Summer school I.D. cards will be sold for \$5.00. Students must go to the assigned location to purchase an I.D. card between 7:30 a.m. and 7:55 a.m. to avoid a tardy.
3. Students are to go directly to the cafeteria during breaks. Students are not allowed to leave the building or linger in the hallways during this time. Students are to remain quiet in the halls while passing to the cafeteria to afford others an opportunity to learn.
4. Students must dress appropriately at all times. Students will not be allowed in class with revealing clothing. If inappropriate attire is worn, students will be sent home to retrieve appropriate school attire or must have appropriate clothing brought to them. However, the time taken to dress appropriately will be counted as a tardy absence from class. Inappropriate clothing examples are: tank tops, basketball jerseys, shirts/pants with inappropriate writing/pictures, low cut tops, or tube tops. Shorts and skirts must be a least mid-thigh in length and not have slits or cuts in them. Students are not allowed to wear any type of headgear in the building. Administrators will make all final determinations on proper attire.
5. No book bags are allowed. This rule does not apply to students enrolled in swimming courses.
6. Electronic devices, including, but not limited to, pagers, cell phones, radios/headphones, and iPods, are not to be displayed in the building. If displayed, these items will be confiscated by staff members.
7. Smoking is a violation of local ordinance. Possession of any smoking material/product is a violation of the rules. All smoking materials will be confiscated and tickets will be issued by the police.
