

# **TASP Student Rules and Responsibilities**

- ❖ ID's must be worn at all times.
- ❖ No coats, bookbags, food, drink, or candy will be allowed in the library.
- ❖ All students must be in the library by **3:05 p.m.** Students arriving later than this are required to have a pass, or they will not be admitted. The program runs from 3:05 until 4:05 p.m.
- ❖ Students must report to the area that they sign-in to and stay there (English/Social Science Room, Math/Science Room, Silent Reading Room, or Computer Area). If a student is finished with homework and then needs to use a computer, then s/he must inform a staff member.
- ❖ Students must bring homework or study materials. Those with nothing to do will be assigned to a computer to use the My Skills Tutor or Plato programs.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the student to inform staff if they need help with homework, the assistance of a tutor, problems with a computer, etc.
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the student to let the tutor/teacher they are working with know if they do not understand the material that is being explained to them.
- ❖ Students will respect the quiet atmosphere of the library: no loud talking, no horseplay, etc.
- ❖ All normal school rules still apply after school. For example, cell phones are **not allowed**. If a student is using a cell phone, it will be confiscated and penalties will be issued as appropriate. If there are questions about this or any other school rule, please refer to the Student Handbook.
- ❖ **Please be reminded that as a part of the Thornridge After School Program (TASP), you are required to have your parent/guardian fill out the registration form, and pay the registration fee.**
- ❖ **If these rules are not adhered to, the student WILL be asked to leave the program.**
