
In addition, if your comments are of a critical nature about specific people, the Board requests that you present your comments during the personnel portion of the "executive session."






The objective of the activity was to support a student's comprehension of a unit of sale. They had to understand that you can't sell a unit for less than the amount of the expense to produce the product or service. We had 20 student popup shops in the cafeteria during all lunch periods.

The students had to manufacture their product, determine the price to produce it, then produce a selling price that maximized profit. During this time, all our students were extremely engaged in the process of making a sale. Our students sold everything from cupcakes to jewelry.
